ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP; \$6,288 per year 3.4 - 3.59 (unweighted and recalculation of core GPA) may qualify a student for FMU's Academic Achievement Scholarship.

**UNDERGRADUATE TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP**; \$4,000 per year 3.0 GPA with a minimum of 30 transferable credit hours may qualify a student for FMU's Transfer Scholarship.

#### **OCTOBER 1**

The 2020-2021 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) becomes available online at www.FAFSA.gov

#### March 1

Priority Deadline: Your 2020-2021 FAFSA application should be completed and all missing documents turned into the Office of Financial Aid to determine your eligibility.

## GENERAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR

#### **FEDERAL AID**

To be considered for the Federal Financial Aid programs a student must be:

- A citizen, national or eligible noncitizen of the United States with a valid Social Security Number.
- Registered with Selective Service if required to do so by law.
- Accepted and enrolled into a degree seeking program at least half-time.
- 4. Maintaining satisfactory academic progress.
- Meet credit criteria established by U.S. Dept. of Education for Direct PLUS Loans.
- 6. Not owe a refund or be in default of any Title IV funds.

To be considered for assistance you will need to complete the following:

- Request your Federal Student Aid Identification (FSA ID): At <u>www.fsaid.ed.gov</u>. Your FSA ID is used to electronically apply for federal student aid and access your federal student aid records online. Your FSA ID serves as your electronic signature. Be sure to keep your FSA ID in a safe place.
  - Dependent students: Parent/Guardian will also need to request a FSA ID.
- Complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA): At <a href="www.FAFSA.gov">www.FAFSA.gov</a>. The result of your FAFSA is called the Student Aid Report (SAR) and it summarizes the data you reported on your application. To ensure timely completion of your financial aid package PLEASE CHOOSE THE DATA RETRIEVAL TOOL OPTION when completing your application.
  - Florida Memorial University's School Code is 001486
  - You can complete your FAFSA using 2017 Tax Forms
  - Priority Deadline: March 1
- Submit Required Documents: In order to receive an award, you must complete any missing documents. Admitted students can find out and access required documents by using their student financial aid portal; the LION AID SYSTEM. The portal can be accessed via the University website at <a href="https://www.fmuniv.edu/FA">www.fmuniv.edu/FA</a>.
  - LION AID SYSTEM: Students must use their student ID number to gain access.
  - For Example: Pooo12345
- 4. Complete the Florida Resident Access Grant Application: (FL RESIDENTS ONLY) In order to qualify for Florida State funds you must complete the FRAG application at <a href="https://www.fmuniv.edu/FA">www.fmuniv.edu/FA</a>. Florida residents are required to provide two forms of Florida residency documentation. These documents MUST prove residency for at least 12 consecutive months, prior to enrolling in school. A list of eligible documents are listed on the back of the FRAG application.
  - Dependent students must provide proof that parent(s) are Florida residents.
- 5. Complete Verification: (Only if selected by FAFSA) Review your (SAR) student aid report that was sent to your email address listed on the FAFSA. FOR STEP BY STEP VERIFICATION, PLEASE SEE THE FMU VERIFICATION GUIDE or visit www.fmuniv.edu/FA for more information.
  - Use the DATA RETRIEVAL TOOL to transfer IRS data directly to your FAFSA (www.FAFSA.gov)
  - Request IRS TAX RETURN TRANSCRIPTS at www.IRS.gov or 1 (800) 908-9946.
- Complete UNCF General Application: Visit <u>www.UNCF.org</u> to complete the general application. Also, review UNCF's website for other scholarship opportunities. The Office of Financial Aid conducts regular scholarship workshops. Visit the Office of Financial Aid for more details.
- Complete the Master Promissory Note (MPN) and Entrance Counseling: For your Federal
  Direct Stafford Loans. MPN and Entrance Counseling only have to be completed once.
  Both the MPN and Entrance Counseling can be completed at the following website:
  www.studentloans.gov.
- 8. Parent PLUS Loan Option: Parent(s) can apply for a Direct PLUS Loan to assist with college expenses. If the loan is denied, student can qualify for an additional \$4,000 (freshmen or sophomore) and \$5,000 (Junior or Senior) in the Federal Direct Unsubsidized Stafford Loan. Parent can apply by completing the PLUS Loan request form (www.fmuniv.edu/FA) or applying directly on the web at www.studentloans.gov using the parent FSA ID. If PLUS loan is added to student account, the parent must complete a PLUS Loan Counseling & MPN.
- 9. Accept your Award: To accept your awards, click on the "Your Awards" Tab from the Lion Aid System at <a href="http://www.fmuniv.edu/FA">http://www.fmuniv.edu/FA</a>. If you financial aid application is incomplete and you're missing required documentation your financial aid will not be disbursed.
- 10. Alternative Loans Options: Private alternative loans help bridge the remaining gap from the awarded amount compared to the amount needed to meet COA. A separate application is required directly with the lender. Listed on the left are lenders you and your Parent may want to consider.



The following Estimated Cost of Attendance (COA) is based on full-time (12-18 credit hours) enrollment, as an undergraduate student attending Florida Memorial University.

Once a student is notified by the Office of Financial Aid that they have been awarded the student will be able to view, accept or decline their financial aid award.
